The Hanen Program® teaches you step by step how to use practical strategies to help your child learn language naturally throughout the day. It also focuses on improving the communication with your child and how you can become your child's most important language coach.

The program contains of 7 group sessions and 4 home visits, covering a period of approximately 4 months. The first home visit will take place before the first group session. Filming the interaction and analysing these moments together is an important part of the program. As well as sharing with and learning from other parents.

For who?

The Hanen Program® is designed specifically for parents of young children with a language delay. A family can join the Hanen Program® if:

- ✓ Your child has a communication problem / language delay;
- ✓ Your child has the age of 1,5-5 years;
- ✓ Your child does not or hardly speak (max. of 3 word-sentences);
- ✓ You're willing to make an effort for the benefit of your child's language development.
